



## Grey Tank Start Up & Maintenance Guide (For Tanks up to 150L)

### Congratulations on your new van / grey tank!

Grey tanks are known to smell more due to their inorganic content. **ProPower** is able to assist you in keeping your Grey Tank free of odours, sludge, crystallisation and gummed up sensors! The beauty of ProPower is that it is 100% Natural, Non-Toxic and good for the environment! (It utilises nature's cleaning microbes that have been working hard for millions of years and by putting them in your tank they will feast on all that is nasty keeping your tank clean.)

### First Time Use

Shake bottle and pour 100ml into a small bucket of water, pour down all drains that run into the Grey Tank. **Tip:** Do this at the end of the day after their consistent use so that our microbes can start cleaning your pipes.

### Emptying Grey Tanks

Once your tank is full, open the gate valve and empty contents, when the flow reduces to a trickle shut the valve thereby keeping a small amount in your tank. This is already treated and has our microbes inside, allowing your continuing doses to half of the first!

**Note:** ProPower is excellent for Septic/Bio Systems and Town Sewer.

### Continuing Use

Shake bottle and pour 50ml into a small bucket of water and pour some down all drains that run into the Grey Tank. **Tip:** If you follow the previous tip, you will clean your piping every time you dose the system.
